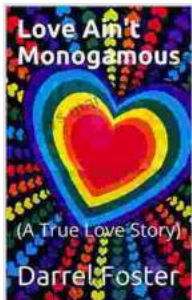


Love Ain't Monogamous: A True Love Story that Challenges the Norm

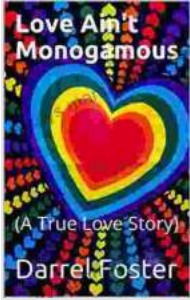

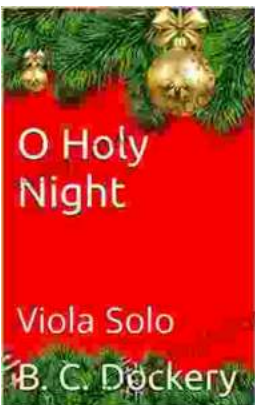
