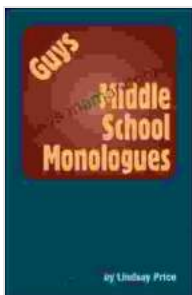


Middle School Monologues Guys: Lindsay Price

The Artist

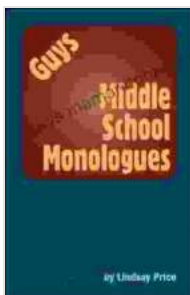
I'm an artist. I love to draw, paint, and sculpt. I'm not the best artist in the world, but I'm good. And I'm always trying to get better.

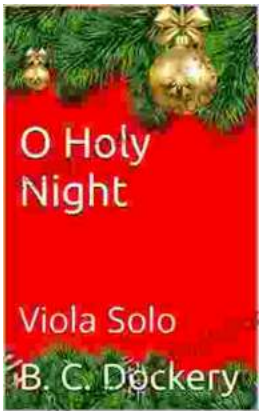
